1 Meeting Called To Order

2 Purpose of Public Hearing

The Administrator advised those in attendance that the purpose of this public hearing is to allow the public and council the opportunity to discuss and ask and answer questions in regards to an Amendment to the Municipal Zoning Bylaw which Council at their January 2020 Regular Council meeting gave first reading to Bylaw No. 2020-02, which provides for an amendment to the Municipal Zoning Bylaw No. 03-09.

The proposed amendment will provide for the following:

- Application and issuance of Development Permits for all permanent farm/agricultural buildings and structures. There will be no cost to a landowner to obtain this type of development permit.
- This will ensure that all farm/ag buildings constructed in the municipality will conform to the requirements of municipal bylaws and that the municipality is aware of these type of developments
- This amendment will affect all lands within an agricultural district.

The proposed amendment will also provide for the following:

- Development of municipal facilities as a permitted use in all municipal zoning districts. This will allow the
 council to develop municipal facilities throughout the municipal as and if required.
- This amendment will affect all land districts within the municipality.
