Burr Conservation & Development Authority - Lateral Project

- North Crossing Replace existing culverts with 2 x 600 mm culvert (angled installation)
- South Crossing Replace an existing 600mm with 1 x 1030 mm x 740 mm and leaving two other existing culverts in place (not angled)

Further, if the above approved culvert options are not satisfactory to the BCDAA, the municipality will allow for the other proposed culvert option, however any increase in culvert and installation costs would be the responsibility of the BCDAA.
