Councillor Dale recused himself from the Council Table to sit as the public as he is applying for a Discretionary Use Permit for the development of a gravel pit of lands that he owns, that being the NE 7 NW 8-35-24 W2.

Reeve Gibney called the Public Hearing for the Discretionary Use Permit for the Development of a Gravel Pit on the NE 7 & NW 8-35-24 W2 at 9:07 am and welcomed Mr. Rod Dale to the hearing.

**Purpose of Public Hearing**

The Administrator advised those in attendance that the Public Hearing was in regards to a Discretionary Use Permit Application for the development of a gravel pit proposed on the NE 7 & NW 8-35-24 W2.

Public Notice was posted via advertisements on the RM website, RM bulletin board, Lanigan Advisor and Humboldt Journal (online) and letter were sent out in accordance with legislation.

**Submissions & Discussions**

The Administrator advised those in attendance that no written submissions were submitted to the RM office.

The Council reviewed the Discretionary Use Permit as submitted. Mr. Dale provided information such as proposed development acres and developing an area for private use and an area that may be developed from the commercial sale of gravel.

Reclamation on the site was also discussed as well as set back distances from the community well and Sask Power poles and overhead lines.

Mr. Dale commented that he felt that road maintenance agreements for gravel hauled from private gravel pits, for use by the land owner, should not be dealt with in the same manner as commercial or large hauls and that some of the gravel hauled should be exempt from road maintenance fees.

Mr. Dale was thanked for his attendance.




