Road Maintenance Agreement For Gravel Hauls From Privately Owned Gravel Pits

Gravel being hauled on municipal roads from private gravel pits will be dealt with in the following manner:

- 1) When gravel is being hauled out of a private pit and is for personal use (ie not being sold), a road maintenance agreement will not be required when the volume of haul is less than 250 cu. Yds or its equivalent.
- 2) The exemption of 250 cu Yds or its equivalent will be based on a calendar year.
- 3) Gravel Extraction Fees will not apply on the first 250 cu Yds or its equivalent that are removed in a calendar year.
- 4) Road Maintenance Agreements for haul volumes exceeding 250 cu Yds or its equivalent for personal use must be approved by Council.
- 5) When required and in order to facilitate a timely haul approval the following will apply:
- The RM administration will require a minimum of 1 business days' notice that a road maintenance agreement is required. The hauler must provide the RM with the following information:
 - ➤ Name and location of resident/landowner being hauled to
 - Haul Route Information road information and how many miles of haul road being used
 - Amount of aggregate/product being hauled
 - Timeline of haul starting and ending date
 - How many trucks hauling
 - Contact information of hauler to include name, address, phone numbers and email addresses.
- When applicable, road maintenance fees will be billed on aggregate hauls when the fees are greater than \$20.00 (excluding GST).
- 6) When gravel is being hauled out of a private pit and is being sold for commercial use, a road maintenance agreement will be required and there will be no volume exemption or gravel extraction fee exemption applied.
