## Revenues

- Abatements & Adjustments – decrease from \$ -1,000 to -\$1,500
- Fees & Charges
  - o Custom Work - General – increase from \$0.00 to \$40,000
  - o Custom Work – Gravel Haul – increase from \$0.00 to \$25,000
  - o Custom Work – Snow Removal – increase from \$0.00 to \$9,500
- Other Revenue
  - o Tax Enforcement Collection – increase from \$0.00 to \$4,000
  - o Fire Fees Collected – increase from \$18,400 to \$18,416

## Expenses

- General Government
  - o Wages – Administrative Assistant – increase from \$35,000 to \$40,000
  - o Benefits – Administrative Assistant – increase from \$4,000 to \$4,500
  - o Computer/Copier Equipment Contract Services – increase from \$12,000 to \$17,000
  - o First Aid Supplies – increase from \$100 to \$500
- Transportation Services
  - o Contracted Maintenance – increase from \$35,000 to \$36,000
  - o Culverts/Drainage – increase from \$12,500 to \$22,500
  - o Tangible Capital Asset Expenditures – increase from \$51,940 to \$96,940
- Environmental, Health & Welfare
  - o Contracted Weed Control – increase from \$20,000 to \$25,000

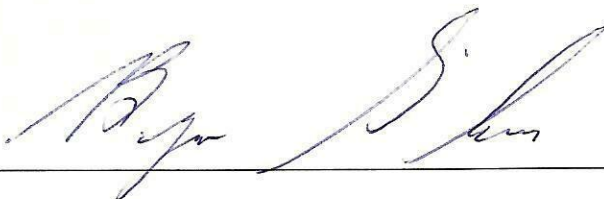
